



Family Perceptions of Pyramid Model Implementation

Family members were surveyed about their family's experience at their child's program implementing the Pyramid Model.

Family/Program Partnerships

Families surveyed Strongly Agree/Agree...



- 99% The program staff made my family feel welcome.
- 99% The program staff listened to my concerns about my child.
- 99% The program staff were respectful to my child.
- 95% I feel satisfied with my involvement at my child's program as a parent.
- 95% I have a good understanding of my child's educational progress.
- 96% My opinion(s) about my child are respected by program staff.
- 99% I feel comfortable talking to my child's teachers about my concerns.
- 96% I would recommend my child's program to other families of young children.
- 92% I feel satisfied with the representation of my family's language and culture in the classroom.

Child Outcomes

Families surveyed Strongly Agree/Agree...



- 95% My child has learned the school and classroom rules.
- 94% My child has learned to make new friends.
- 81% My child learned how to resolve conflicts with other children.
- 89% My child has learned to be more sensitive to other people's feelings.
- 91% My child has more self-confidence after attending this program.
- 96% Overall, I think my child has made excellent progress while at this program.
- 81% Life at home with my child is easier after attending this program.
- 91% The practices used by staff at my child's program to respond to children's behavior problems are ones I am comfortable with.

“He has excelled in his speech and ability to talk, he has learned to share and interact with kids and he has learned a lot of colors and letters with this program.”

“How to interact with other children. Becoming more outgoing. Becoming more independent.”

“She has learned to freely express herself, which was encouraged by her teacher.”

“Learning about his and his peers' feelings and how to deal with them, how to resolve issues without anger.”
